

Suggested Sailing Itinerary



PACIFIC SAILING SCHOOL Mediterranean Odyssey!

Day 1:

In conjunction with Charter World Yachting Holidays*

6-24 September 2018
(13 nights, 14 days)

Board the modern 45 foot yacht at Kalamaki Marina for a briefing and inventory check. Enjoy your first night afloat in the marina or try your first Greek salad at a nearby taverna.

→ Overnight: Kalamaki

Day 2:

Depart Kalamaki Marina for the first downwind sail to Kea, a craggy mountainous island with its major peak rising 1840 ft above sea level. Ayios Nikulaos is a major harbor offering a variety of restaurants and shopping.

→ Overnight: Kea (approx. 35 miles)

Day 3:

To Siros, a hilly and mostly barren island which was originally the Capital of all the Cyclades. The buildings around the harbor reflect the past power and glory, although it is now only a sleepy village port.

→ Overnight: Siros (approx. 35 miles)

Day 4:


An afternoon sail to Mykonos, known as the tourist mecca of Greece. Enjoy watching the foreshore activities from the cockpit of our yacht.

→ Overnight: Mykonos (approx. 25 miles)

Day 5:

To Paros, a typical Cyclades island which offers one of the most beautiful harbours in the region. Naossa is the major port offering good shelter and a variety of restaurants.

→ Overnight: Paros (approx. 25 miles)





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Day 6:

Spend the day exploring this fascinating island.
→ Overnight: Paros

Day 7:

Depart Paros for Serifos, a small and steep protected island. The perfect place to relax and enjoy the surrounding scenery.
→ Overnight: Serifos (approx. 35 miles)

Day 8:

A short sail to Kithnos which is again virtually untouched by tourism. Enjoy a spa in the natural hot mineral springs and contemplate tomorrow's big sail to Hydra.
→ Overnight: Kithnos (approx. 18 miles)

Day 9:

Depart Kithnos early for the legendary island of Hydra which is perhaps the most spectacular island in the Aegean.
→ Overnight: Hydra (approx. 50 miles)

Day 10:

Relax in Hydra Harbour or enjoy shopping in one of the many markets.
→ Overnight: Hydra

Day 11:

Depart Hydra for Poros. This island is extensively wooded with mostly pine but also olive and citrus groves. The township is built on rocky slopes making the approach by sea one of the most beautiful in Greece.
→ Overnight: Poros (approx. 15 miles)

Day 12:

Reluctantly head back to Athens today for your last night abroad in Kalamaki Marina.
→ Overnight: Kalamaki (ATHENS) (approx. 25 miles)

Day 13:

Disembark at Kalamaki Marina around noon.
